## ArtPark + ArtCubes

Managed by cSPACE in partnership with the City of Calgary, the ArtPark provides an outdoor space that is unique, dare we say, in the world. In addition to having the restored heritage school as a backdrop, the park design includes amazing public art by local YYC artists and is inspired by King Edward VII's family tartan (no looking!!). Purpose built with festival infrastructure and wifi, ArtPark is ideal for small outdoor performances, public markets, film screenings and, paired with the ArtCubes, provides an unparalleled outdoor canvas for the imagination.

### Features:

- 0.29 acres or 12,630 sq ft of park space
- High visibility with historic cSPACE King Edward and public art as backdrop to events
- Dedicated exterior event power
- Hard surface installation areas for stages/ tents
- Adjacent concrete pavilions and ArtCubes to provide stage and installation opportunities
- Outdoor projection opportunities
- 4 ArtCubes - 12' x 12' x 12' galvanized steel frames that can be wrapped with different exterior cladding (plywood, polygal, fabric)
- Dedicated loading access
- Tree shading for audiences
- Fully accessible





## Poet's Walk

The laneways of Europe have nothing on our 'woonerf' - a Dutch term for a shared street that is built for equality between pedestrians, cyclists and cars. With housing and trees lining its length, this hard-surfaced extension of the park can morph into a market place, busker haven or canvas for chalk art. Ideal for community events of all colours, its powered, networked and artified. Annual public art installations are interwoven throughout the boulevard, backdropped by the poem commissioned by Calgary's first poet laureate, Kris Demeanor.
